- Consolidated forecasted net income is now \$557,166, a decrease of \$458,138 from the previous forecast of \$1,015,304 due to the following:
 - o Increase in salaries and benefits costs due to a higher number of instructional aides and hours paid than budgeted for (\$294k consolidated increase in expense)
 - o Increase in contracted special education costs (\$165k increase at FACS)
- Overall, cash balances and fiscal health remain strong despite decrease in operating income.
